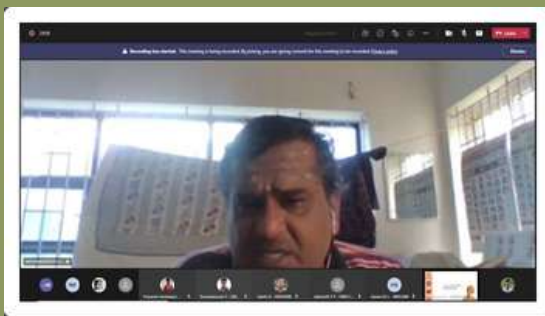

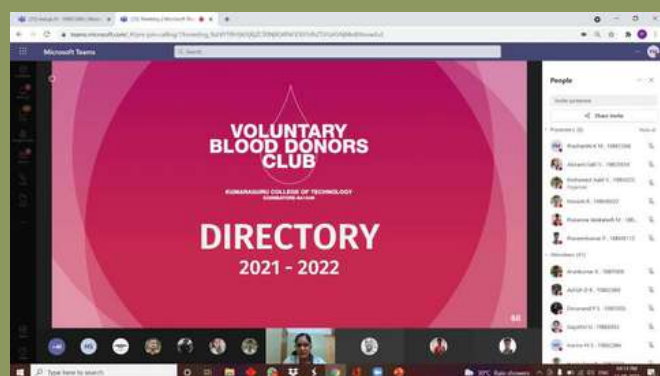
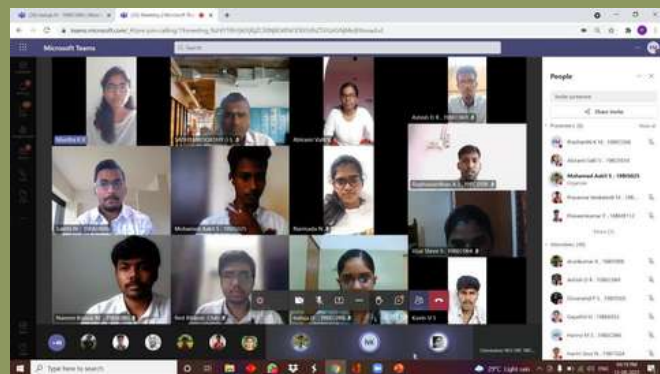
The main idea of this event was to offer students a clear picture of career paths available to them. Overall, more than 120 students got benefitted in this event.

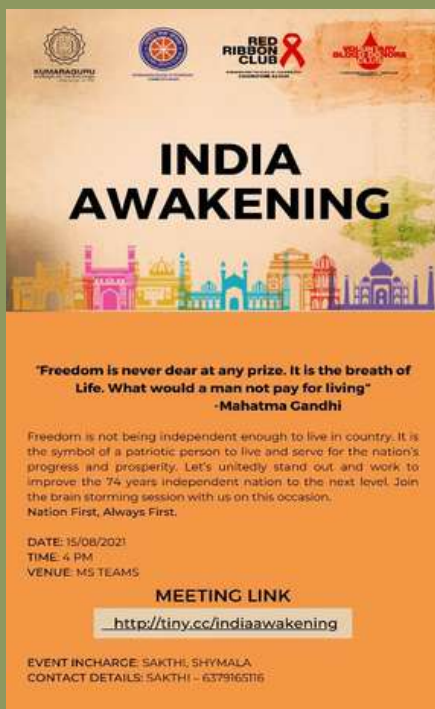

India Awakening

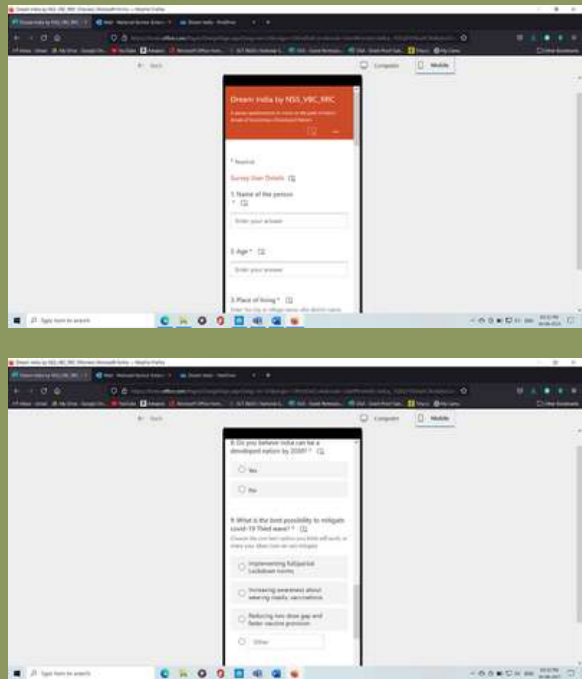

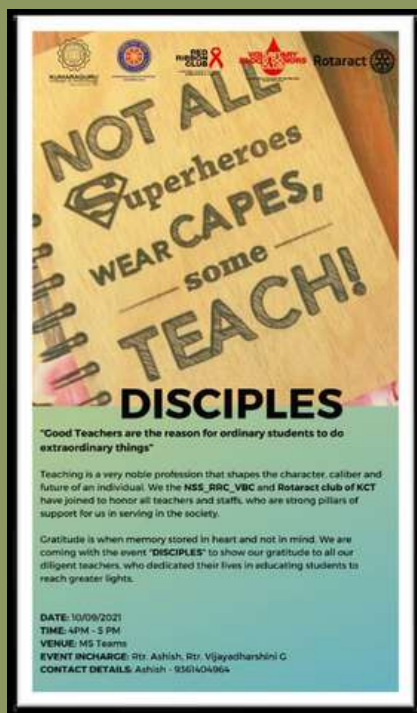

Disciples

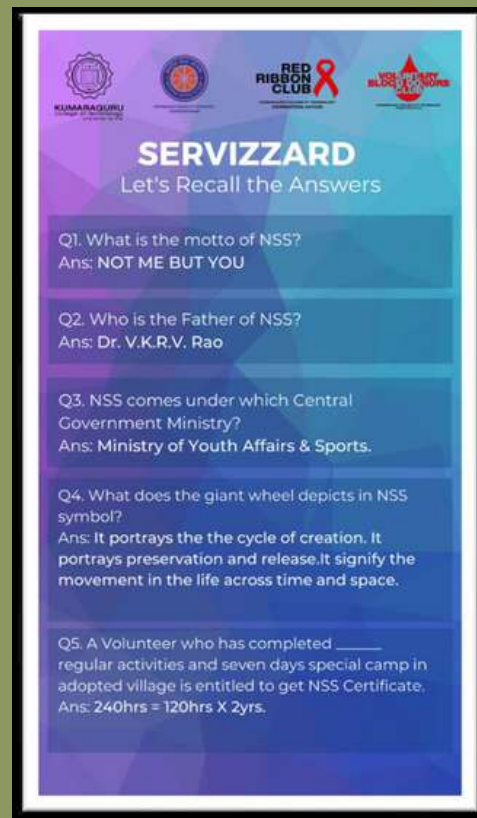

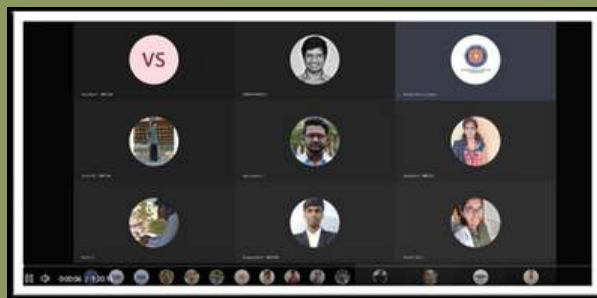
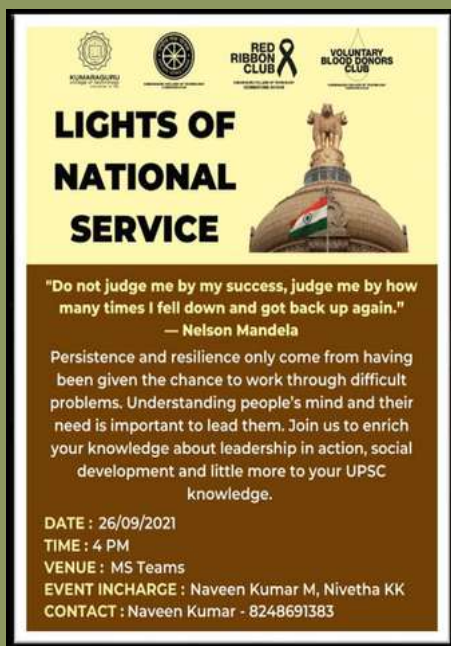

Lights of National Service

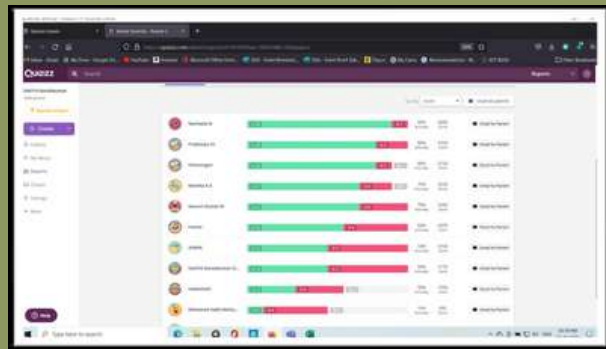
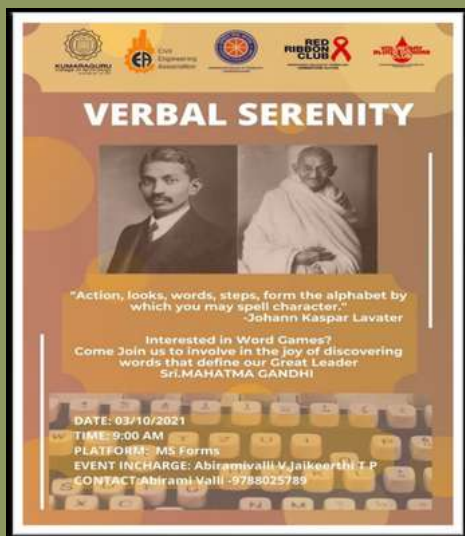

This event enhanced the knowledge on various diseases and their respective causative agents through a Crossword puzzle. The winners were announced on the basis of time taken to complete.

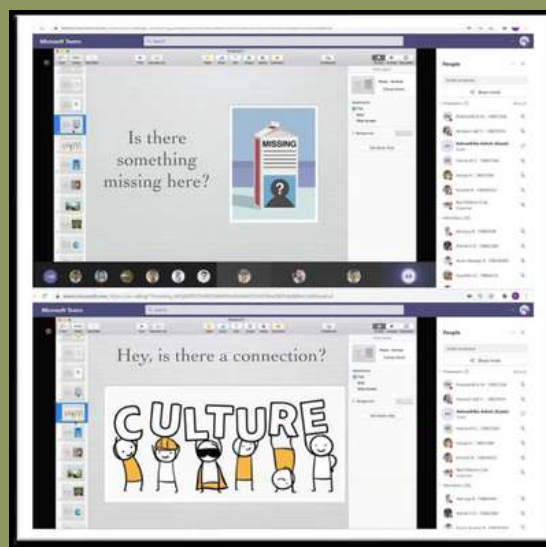

Sithiram Pesum

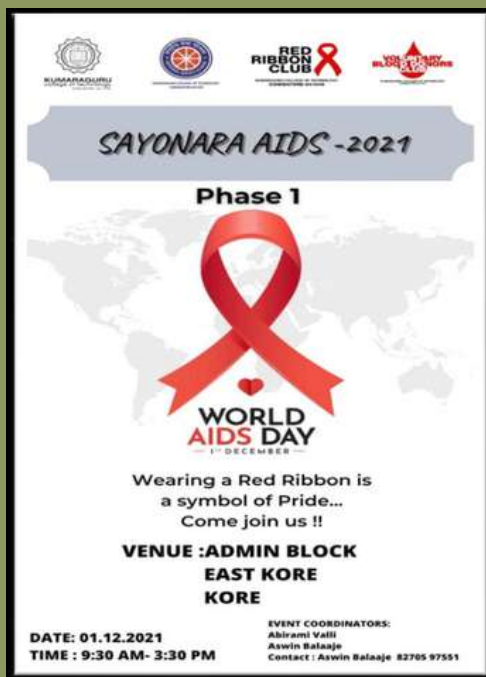
