


NCC ANNUAL REPORT

HOMAGE FOR BIPIN RAWAT:



The vital qualities of a good military leader include decisiveness, endurance, and integrity. General Bipin Rawat is an exceptional leader who was the first Chief of Defence Staff. He was born on 16th March 1958. On Dec 1978, he was commissioned into the 5th battalion of 11 Gorkha Rifles. He was the vice chief of the army staff and then became the 27th chief of the army staff. He carried out surgical strikes at Pakistan and Myanmar intellectually. He commanded the Rashtriya Rifles and led the Balakot airstrike.

He was about to retire on December 30, 2019. One day before his retirement, he was appointed as the Chief of Defence Staff. Rawat, as CDS brought many provident reforms which showed his quintessential leadership. Indian Military Academy bestowed 'Sword of Honour' on Bipin Rawat. He received Force Commander's Commendation while he was in the United Nation's Peace-Keeping force. Being a passionate writer, he has authored many articles on

National Security and leadership. The person who is known for his powerful speeches and mighty actions will stand as an exemplary leader forever!

To the sorrowful incident of the chopper getting crashed and to the loss of 13 pious lives, it is our duty to pay the tribute. The Kumaraguru institution, on 13th December, at 11:30 A.M., gathered in front of the MVB to pay the tribute on the college's behalf. The event of tribute began with the Management, authorities, teaching, non-teaching staffs, students amassing to pay tribute to the noble souls. 
